The safety of our patrons, artists, volunteers, and staff is the top priority of The Warehouse Theatre. Due to the rising cases of COVID-19 in South Carolina effective immediately guests must either show proof of either a full vaccination against COVID-19, or a negative COVID-19 PCR test taken within 72 hours prior to the performance start time or a negative COVID-19 antigen test taken within 6 hours of the performance start time.

Proof of vaccination (or negative test result) must come directly from the healthcare provider that performed the vaccination (or test). Guests can show proof of vaccination by presenting a physical vaccination card, a photo of a physical card, or a digital confirmation of vaccination. Once this has been verified, guests will be granted access to the building.

In accordance with these protocols, all guests must present a government-issued photo ID such as a driver's license or passport whose name matches the vaccination or negative test result.

Once granted access to the building, we are still requiring that face masks be worn for the duration of the performance.

We ask for your help, cooperation, and grace in enthusiastically complying with these safety precautions. We feel it is necessary to implement this policy in order to reopen our doors safely and ensure we are able to produce in Greenville for another 48+ years. We have been dark for too long, and want nothing more than to return to live in-person performances. The staff and creative teams for all of our shows are vaccinated, but should someone catch COVID we would have to shut the show down, and that is a risk we are trying to avoid at all costs. We want to perform live and in person, but we need to do so safely using all available precautions.

For anyone who is unable or unwilling to wear a mask, and to either provide proof of vaccination or proof of a recent negative test result, we would be happy to offer you a refund. If you would like to request one, please contact [briggs@warehousetheatre.com](mailto:briggs@warehousetheatre.com).
